

# Core VRU data needs workshop

On the 12<sup>th</sup> May 2021 as part of a VRU Data Workshop event, Anja Kimberley, Head of Performance and Information for the Hampshire and Isle of Wight Police and Crime Commissioner's Office, Chloe Froggett, VRU Knowledge Hub Manager, West Yorkshire Violence Reduction Unit, Julia Pitman, consultant to the HIOW OPCC and Gill Wren, Information Management Officer, facilitated a workshop to explore the generic needs that cut across all Violence Reduction Units, to report on progress already made and to discuss barriers to delivery.

The session also included an opportunity to explore the most effective ways in which everyone could benefit from changes and potential for people to engage in future development.

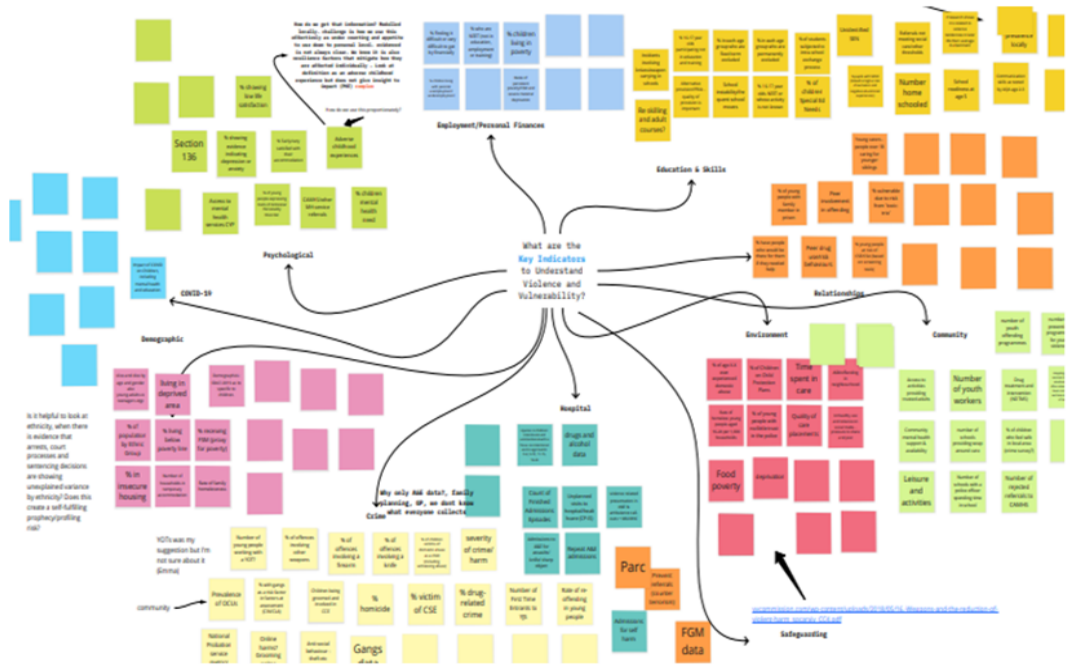
## InterACT - Hampshire and Isle of Wight OPCC

Hampshire and IOW OPCC has developed an interactive data visualisation tool called InterACT. We have been working with other VRU units around the country to explore whether InterACT can be used as a tool for the VRUs to be able to standardise data collection and definitions and for data visualisation.

Consultation workshops with key stakeholders focused on three questions:

- key challenges in terms of data related to violence and vulnerability
- key indicators and data sets for understanding violence and vulnerability
- Where these are currently held/how we might access them

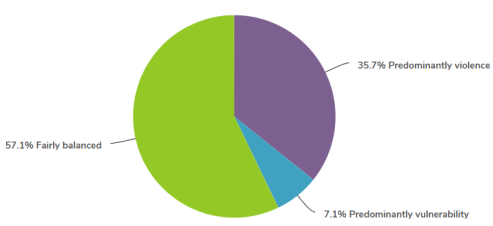
